

To our Valued Customers,

The growing season is coming to an end and harvest will be here soon!

As we prepare for harvest, your cooperation with the following is appreciated:

- ✓ Notify us if you want to store or sell your grain as you complete each field.
Grain from each field will automatically be stored five (5) days after completion or lack of activity.
- ✓ Tenants – it is your responsibility to keep landlords informed of grain deliveries.
- ✓ Advise the Deer Creek office when to apply bushels to your fall contracts.
Payments for contracts will not be made until we are told to do so.
- ✓ Contact the Deer Creek office if you have new farm names and/or splits OR need to make any changes to an existing farm name. *This will avoid delays at the elevator!*
- ✓ Be sure your drivers have correct information to give the scale operator - **first and last name AND farm name.**
- ✓ Encourage your driver to check their scale ticket for accuracy **before** leaving the elevator – this is your grain receipt!
- ✓ As a courtesy, please ask your drivers to give priority to empty trucks over loaded trucks at the scales.
- ✓ If you have old grain in the elevator at the end of September, you will receive a storage bill during October which will be due November 1, 2017. This will be for a full year's storage.

Non GMO Bean Customers:

- ✓ Drivers **MUST** communicate with the scale operator in Congerville and/or Deer Creek that they have Non-GMO beans **BEFORE** dumping!
- ✓ There is zero tolerance for corn in Non-GMO beans
- ✓ **Moisture content should be below 13.8%**
